



Well Child Policy

A child should not be placed in a class when any of the following exist:

- Fever over 100°F, currently or within the last 24 hours.
- Vomiting or diarrhea, currently or within the last 24 hours.
- Colored discharge from the nose from the onset through one week.
- Productive (wet) cough or croupy (barking) cough.
- Sore throat.
- Any unexplained rash, or open skin lesion.
- Any skin infection — boils, ringworm, impetigo, etc.
- Any eye infection or drainage.
- Any communicable disease or infestation (such as lice).
- Looks or acts unusually tired, pale, irritable or restless.
